ISSUANCE OF FUNDS

Funds shall be issued to Scholarship Recipients only after (s)/he presents to the National Scholarship Committee proof of enrollment from an accredited college for the fall term.

- An announcement of the Scholarship recipients will be made at the Banquet at the Booker T. Washington High School National Reunion in July 2022.
- 3. Funds for the **CLAUDIUS N. SHROPSHIRE, JR., M. D. SCHOLARSHIP** will be distributed in October or November to the awardees as soon as college officials verify their enrollment at the institution to the National Scholarship Chairman.
